Khatra Sub-Division: A Profile

Khatra sub-division (Bengali: খাতড়া মহকুমা) is a subdivision of the Bankura district. It consists of eight community development blocks: Indpur, Khatra, Hirbandh, Raipur, Sarenga, Ranibandh, Simlapal and Taldangra. The eight blocks contain 59 gram panchayats. The sub-division has its headquarters at Khatra. Khatra is in the south-west of Bankura District, which is itself to the west of the southern part of West Bengal. Khatra is located at 22°59'N 86°51'E 22.98°N 86.85°E, and has an average elevation of 154 m (505 ft).

Blocks :

Indpur block

Indpur (Community development block) (Bengali: ইন্দপুর সমষ্টি উন্নয়ন ব্লক) is an administrative division in Khatra subdivision. Indpur police station serves this block. Headquarters of this block is at Indpur.

Geography

Indpur is located at 23°10'00"N 86°56'00"E 23.1667°N 86.9333°E. It has an average elevation of 118 m (387 ft). Indpur community development block has an area of 300.20 km².

Gram panchayats

Gram panchayats of Indpur block/ panchayat samiti are: Bhdeuasole, Brahmandiha, Brajarajpur, Gourbazar, Hatgram, Indpur and Raghunathpur.

Transport

Indpur is situated midway between Bankura and Khatra on the road connecting the two towns.

Demographics

In the 2001 census, Indpur community development block had a total population of 137,825 of which 70,990 were males and 66,835 were females. Decadal growth for the period 1991-2001 was 10.15% for Indpur, against 13.79% in Bankura district. Decadal growth in West Bengal was 40.13%. Indpur Block has a total scheduled caste population of 52613 and a scheduled tribe population of 13505.

Khatra block

Khatra (Community development block) (Bengali: খাতড়া সমষ্টি উন্নয়ন ব্লক) is an administrative division in Khatra subdivision. Khatra police station serves this block. Headquarters of this block is at Khatra.

Geography

Khatra is located at 22°59'N 86°51'E22.98°N 86.85°E. Khatra community development block has an area of 232.40 km².

Gram panchayats

Gram panchayats of Khatra block / panchayat samiti are: Baidyanathpur, Dahala, Dhanra, Gorabari, Khatra I, Khatra II and Supur.

Demographics

As per 2001 census, Khatra block had a total population of 102,569, out of which 52,563 were males and 50,006 were females. Khatra block registered a population growth of 14.73 per cent during the 1991-2001 decade. Decadal growth for the district was 13.79 per cent. Decadal growth in West Bengal was 17.84 per cent.

Hirbandh block

Hirbandh (Community development block) (Bengali: হীরাবাঁধ সমষ্টি উন্নয়ন ব্লক) is an administrative division in Khatra subdivision of Bankura district in the Indian state of West Bengal. Khatra police station serves this block. Headquarters of this block is at Hirbandh.

Geography

Hirbandh is located at 23°03'48"N 86°48'08"E23.0633859°N 86.8022919°E Hirbandh community development block has an area of 215.80 km².

Gram panchayats

Gram panchayats of Indpur block/ panchayat samiti are: Baharamuri, Gopalpur, Hirbandh, Malian and Mashiara.

Demographics

In the 2001 census, Hirbandh community development block had a total population of 72,502 of which 37,301 were males and 35,201 were females. Decadal growth for the period 1991-2001 was 16.53% for Hirbandh, against 13.79% in Bankura district. Decadal growth in West Bengal was 17.84%.

Raipur block

Raipur (Community development block) (Bengali: রাইপুর সমষ্টি উন্নয়ন ব্লক) is an administrative division in Khatra subdivision. Raipur and Barikul police station serve this block. Headquarters of this block is at Gar Raipur.

Geography

Raipur is located at 22°48'N 86°57'E22.80°N 86.95°E. Raipur community development block has an area of 364.40 km².

Gram panchayats

Gram panchayats of Raipur block/ panchayat samiti are: Dundar, Dhanara, Dheko, Mandalkuli, Matgoda, Melera, Phulkusma, Raipur, Shyamsundarpur and Sonagara.

Demographics

As per 2001 census, Raipur block had a total population of 151,293, out of which 77,252 were males and 74,041 were females. Raipur block registered a population growth of 40.13 per cent during the 1991-2001 decade. Decadal growth for the district was 13.79 per cent. Decadal growth in West Bengal was 17.84 per cent.

Sarenga block

Sarenga (Community development block) (Bengali: সারেন্গা সমষ্টি উন্নয়ন ব্লক) is an administrative division in Khatra subdivision. Sarenga police station serves this block. Headquarters of this block is at Sarenga.

Geography

Sarenga is located at 22°46'00"N 87°02'00"E22.7667°N 87.0333°E. Sarenga community development block has an area of 228.07 km².

Gram panchayats

Gram panchayats of Sarenga block/ panchayat samiti are: Bikrampur, Chiltora, Gargarya, Goalbari and Nuturpur.

Demographics

As per 2001 census, Sarenga block had a total population of 95,128, out of which 48,759 were males and 46,369 were females. Sarenga block registered a negative population growth of -11.88 per cent during the 1991-2001 decade. Decadal growth for the district was 13.79 per cent. Decadal growth in West Bengal was 17.84 per cent. Sarenga block had a total scheduled caste population of 26,443 and a scheduled tribe population of 18,848.

Ranibandh block

Ranibandh (Community development block) (Bengali: রানীবাঁধ সমষ্টি উন্নয়ন ব্লক) is an administrative division in Khatra subdivision. Ranibandh and Barikul police station serve this block. Headquarters of this block is at Ranibandh.

Geography

Ranibandh is located at 22°51'50"N 86°47'05"E22.8639200°N 86.7846070°E.Ranibandh community development block has an area of 428.40 km².

Gram panchayats

Gram panchayats of Ranibandh block/ panchayat samiti are: Ambikanagar, Barikul, Haludkanali, Puddi, Rajakata, Ranibandh, Routora and Rudra.

Demographics

As per 2001 census, Ranibandh block had a total population of 104,326, out of which 53,168 were males and 51158 were females. Ranibandh block registered a population growth of 11.27 per cent during the 1991-2001 decade. Decadal growth for the district was 13.79 per cent. Decadal growth in West Bengal was 17.84 per cent.

Simlapal block

Simlapal (Community development block) (Bengali: সিমলাপাল সমষ্টি উন্নয়ন ব্লক) is an administrative division in Khatra subdivision of Bankura district. Simlapal police station serves this block. Headquarters of this block is at Simlapal.

Geography

Simlapal is located at 22°55'22"N 87°04'24"E22.9227°N 87.0734°E.Simlapal community development block has an area of 309.20 km².

Gram panchayats

Gram panchayats of Simlapal block/ panchayat samiti are: Bikrampur, Dubrajpur, Laxmisagar, Machtora, Mandalgram, Parsola and Simlapal.

Demographics

As per 2001 census, Simlapal block had a total population of 127,445 out of which 65,297 were males and 62,148 were females. Simlapal block registered a population growth of 14.48 per cent during the 1991-2001 decade. Decadal growth for the district was 13.79 per cent. Decadal growth in West Bengal was 17.84 per cent.

Taldangra block

Taldangra (Community development block) (Bengali: তালডাঙড়া সমষ্টি উন্নয়ন ব্লক) is an administrative division in Khatra subdivision of Bankura district. Taldangra police station serves this block. Headquarters of this block is at Taldangra.

Geography

Taldangra is located at 23°01'N 87°07'E23.02°N 87.11°E. Taldangra community development block has an area of 349.70 km².

Gram panchayats

Gram panchayats of Taldangra block/ panchayat samiti are: Amdangra, Bibarda, Fulmati, Harnasra, Khalagram, Panchmura, Saltora, Satmouli and Taldangra.

Demographics

As per 2001 census, Taldangra block had a total population of 128,747, out of which 65,713 were males and 63,034 were females. Taldangra block registered a population growth of 15.39 per cent during the 1991-2001 decade. Decadal growth for the district was 13.79 per cent. Decadal growth in West Bengal was 17.84 per cent..

Legislative segments

As per order of the Delimitation Commission in respect of the delimitation of constituencies in West Bengal, the legislative segments are as follows:

- The three blocks of Ranibandh, Hirbandh and Khatra are under the **Ranibandh Assembly Constituency** of West Bengal.
- The Raipur block and the Sarenga block will define the area under the **Raipur Assembly Constituency**.
- The gram panchayats of Veduasol, Brahmandiha, Hatgram, Indpur and Raghunathpur under the Indpur block are part of the area under the **Chhatna Assembly Constituency**.
- The other two gram panchayats under the Indpur block, the Simplipal block and the gram panchayats of Bibarda, Fulmati, Harnasra, Khalagram, Panchmura and Taldangra under the Taldangra block are under the **Taldangra Assembly Constituency**.
- The other three gram panchayats under the Taldangra block are the part of the domain of the **Bishnupur Assembly Constituency**.
- The constituencies of Ranibandh and Raipur are reserved for Scheduled Tribes (ST) candidates.

All the three constituencies are three assembly segments of the **Bankura (Lok Sabha Constituency)**
